

Suzlon bags 47.6MW wind energy project from KP Group

NEW DELHI: Renewable energy solutions provider Suzlon Group on Tuesday said it has bagged a new order for the development of a 47.6 MW wind power project for The KP Group, the company said in a regulatory filing. The project, it said, is located at Vagra in Bharuch district in Gujarat and is expected to be commissioned in 2024. As part of the order, Suzlon will supply their S133 wind turbines (equipment supply) and supervise execution and commissioning of the project, besides providing comprehensive operations and maintenance services post-commissioning. The company stated that a project of this size can provide electricity to ~36 thousand households and curb ~1.42 lakh tonnes of CO2 emissions per year.
