Suzlon bags 201.6 MW wind energy project orderIndi

Renewables solution provider Suzlon Group on Friday announced that it has bagged a large order for a 201.6 MW wind energy project from Teq Green Power XI, a part of 02 Power. However, the company did not disclose the value of the order in its statement. "Suzlon will supply the wind turbines (equipment supply) and execute the project including erection and commissioning," a Suzlon statement said. The company

will also provide operation and maintenance services postcommissioning. "Suzlon Group today announced a significantly large new order acquisition for its 3 MW series of wind turbines from Teg Green Power XI Pvt Ltd, part of O2 Power Pvt Ltd," it stated. The Suzlon will install 64 of its largest wind turbine generators (WTGs) with a Hybrid Lattice Tubular (HLT) tower and a rated capacity of 3.15 MW each for the 201.6 MW wind power project. The project is expected to be commissioned in 2025.
