

Suzlon bags order for 50.4 MW wind project

Renewable energy solutions provider Suzlon Group has bagged an order for a 50.4 MW wind power project from Juniper Green Energy. The company did not disclose the value of the order.

Suzlon will install 16 wind

turbine generators with a hybrid lattice tubular (HLT) tower of its new product with a rated capacity of 3.15 MW each, according to a statement.

The project is located in Dwarka district in Gujarat, and is expected to be commissioned in 2025. Suzlon will supply the wind turbines and execute the project, including erection and commissioning. It will also

provide comprehensive operations and maintenance services post-commissioning.
